

Summary of Changes

The *Employee and Labor Relations Manual*, Issue 17, constitutes a revision of the ELM 16, including modifications to Chapters 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, and the Appendix.

The Specific Revisions section below summarizes subchapter changes. The changes are organized by section number and in the text of the manual by a revision bar. Language has been added, changed, or rearranged to promote clarity. In addition, language or sections have been deleted and the sections have been renumbered and references changed accordingly.

Subchapter 810, Occupational Safety and Health Program

811.24(a), Safety Philosophy, returned to original language of the safety philosophy to be more precise.

812.3, Installation Heads, is modified with the addition of the new position title *collateral duty facility safety coordinator*.

813.1, Headquarters, is modified with the added words *to provide a safe working environment*.

813.2, Area Offices, is modified with added language on area Human Resource responsibilities to provide technical support to processing and distribution center safety staff and facility safety coordinators.

813.32, Collateral Duty Facility Safety Coordinator, is modified to clarify the duties of the collateral duty facility coordinator.

814.2(b), Responsibilities, is modified with the added words *good housekeeping* to employee responsibilities.

Summary of Changes

815.14, Plant Management Safety and Health Committee, is modified with a change to the title of plant safety and health committee to parallel other committees.

817.2, Safety and Health Staff Training and Education, is modified with the addition of facility safety coordinator.

817.5, OSHA Required Training, is modified with updated references Management Instructions.

817.7, New or Additional Equipment and Techniques Training, is reworded for clarity.

817.9, Training Records, is modified with the deletion of the reference to the Local Employee Training System. New language on documenting safety talks and on-the-job training is added.

Subchapter 820, Reports and Investigations, Program Evaluations, and Inspections

821.141, Postal Accident Log, is modified with a referenced electronic accident log.

821.142, OSHA Annual Summary of Injuries and Illnesses, is modified with a deleted reference to Human Resources Information System.

821.22, Method, item d is modified with a clarified requirement to review on-the-job safety/review analyses following an accident.

822.11, Installation Head Preliminary Serious Accident Report, provides further clarification on when a serious accident report is necessary, based on OSHA guidance on in-patient hospitalization. This reduces workload regarding serious accident reporting and investigation.

822.12, Performance Cluster Manager Report to Area and Headquarters, is modified by changing serious accident reporting to the Area and Headquarters. Only fatalities, amputations, mutilations, and OSHA reportable accidents must be reported to the Area and Headquarters. This reduces reporting workload. Added language requiring the serious accident report follow the format to standardize reports received at Headquarters.

822.21, OSHA Investigations, is modified with the addition of *occupational* before fatalities.

822.221, Mandatory Composition, is modified with the provision for a waiver of serious accident investigation boards when not warranted. This should reduce workload for those serious accidents if an investigation would be of no value to the Postal Service.

822.225, Investigation Reporting and Response Requirements, is modified with the addition of *OSHA reportable*.

823.23, Performance Clusters, is modified with the elimination of duplicative language regarding Area Operations vice president review of evaluations.

823.31, Installations Greater Than 100 Workyears of Employment, is added to provide policy for review of evaluations at these installations.

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823.32, Installations Greater Than 50 and Less Than 100 Workyears of Employment, is added to provide policy for review of evaluations at these installations.

824.2, Methods, is modified with a reference to Safety Toolkit for inspection checklists.

824.32, PC Installations With One Hundred Workyears or More, is retitled.

824.33, PC Installations With Less Than One Hundred Workyears, is retitled.

824.331, Requirement, is modified with revised language to indicate that the collateral duty facility safety coordinator (FSC) will conduct inspections using instructions and a checklist.

824.422, Inspection Rules, is modified with the addition of collateral duty FSC in item a.

824.332, Teams, is reworded for clarity.

824.52, Hazard Abatement Committee, is modified to clarify when postmasters may designate a chair for abatement committees for detached units.

824.54, Reinspection and Followup, is modified by adding the provision for spot checking safety deficiency abatement.

824.633, Approving Official, is modified with the addition of *determined locally*.

824.637, Tenants in Postal Service Buildings, is deleted.

825.451, Management Participation During Inspection, is modified with the addition of FSC.

825.48, Closing Conference, is modified with the addition of FSC.

825.54, Citation Management, is revised by deleting redundant language on Handbook EL-802.

Subchapter 830, Motor Vehicle and Industrial Safety

833.1, Standards, Ergonomics, and Engineering, is modified by changing *procurement* to *purchasing*.

833.3, Supplier (Contractor) Safety, is retitled by changing *contractor* to *supplier* to conform with the *Purchasing Manual*.

Subchapter 840, Safety Awareness Program

844.1, Policy, is revised to clarify language on seat belt usage and the incentive.

Subchapter 850, Emergency Action Plans and Fire Prevention and Control

852.1, Responsibility, is modified with the addition of *tornadoes*, *earthquakes*.

Summary of Changes

852.2, Content, is revised with the addition of *shelters* in item a.

853.13, Duties of EETs, is revised with the addition of another duty for procedures for accounting for all employees after an emergency evacuation.

853.15, Training, is modified with a change to refresher training for emergency evacuation team members from quarterly to annual. Item j has added language on sheltering, tornadoes, and other special situations.

853.18, Installations Without EETs, is modified with the addition of another duty regarding procedures for accounting for all employees after an emergency evacuation.

853.2, Drills, has added language on sheltering drills.

854.1, Responsibility, is modified with the addition of FSC.

855.1, Responsibility, is modified with the deletion of quarterly inspections required for all postal-owned and postal-leased installations.

855.2, Frequency, is modified with a change regarding fire inspection frequency to semi-annual for installations less than 100 workyears.

855.3, Procedures, is relocated from 855.2 with added language on the Safety Toolkit.

855.4, Corrective Action, is relocated from 855.2.

Chapter 9, Labor Unions

Subchapter 930, Work Clothes and Uniforms

934.3, Warm Weather Items — Type I Uniforms (see 933.111), is retitled.

934.32, Summer Shirt and Tie, is modified with the addition of *union representatives*.

938.324, Replacements, is modified with the change of the amount of reimbursement for replacement work clothes to \$54.
